Abstract Submission Guidelines for Paper Presentation

Abstracts are invited from Graduate, Postgraduate, and PhD students, as well as academicians, clinicians, and professionals in the fields of Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Dietetics and Nutrition, Psychology, Speech and Language Therapy, Special Education, and Prosthetics and Orthotics, who have an interest in Healthcare and Rehabilitation Sciences.

Submission Details

- Abstract submission will commence w.e.f 30th January 2026.
- The abstract must be 250–300 words in length.
- The text should be typed in Times New Roman, with a font size of 12.
- Abstracts must be submitted in Microsoft Word format (.doc or .docx).
- Submissions will be accepted through email only.

All abstracts will undergo a peer review process and will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee. The committee's decision regarding acceptance will be final.

Presentation Guidelines

- Only one author will be permitted to present the paper.
 - Each presenter will be allotted 8–10 minutes for presentation.
 - Participants are advised to plan their presentation for 6–7 minutes, allowing time for introduction and audience questions.
 - The final presentation must be prepared and submitted in PowerPoint (PPT) format.
 - Ensure that all slides are clear, well-organized, and easily legible.
 - Presentation slides must be submitted on or before 31st March 2026 via email to abstractncahrs@gmail.com.
 - Presenters are also required to bring a copy of their presentation on a USB flash drive or other storage device to the event.
 - Selected Scientific papers / Abstracts and proceeding will be published in E-Souvenir or print version with ISBN No.

Guidelines for Poster Presentation

- The maximum allowable size of the poster is 3 feet (width) × 4 feet (height).
- Posters must be prepared in portrait orientation, with the height greater than the width.
- Posters may be printed on paper or flex material, depending on the participant's preference.
- The content should be concise, visually appealing, and easy to read, ensuring clarity for viewers.
- Only one student will be allowed to present the poster.
- For poster presentation only Title of the topic is required. which should be send through at : abstractncahrs@gmail.com

UG, PG and PhD posters will be conducted in offline mode (physically) during the conference days.
